
Using Photoshop to resize images

- -100% Rule: determine what the tightest framing of a picture will be without scaling the picture above 100% in FCP or AVID. Do this:
- -open the picture in photoshop
- -make the Info palette visible
- -set options to Pixels



- -select the Marquee tool
- -eyeball different zooms on the picture using Marquee
- -on the info palette read the width of your tightest framing.
- -devide 1920 by that number
- -in my example 1920/987=1.9
- so I know I have to blow this picture up about 2x to be able to zoom in as far as I want.



- -Image > Image Size
- -Enter the new number for Width
- -Check Scale Styles
- -Constrain Proportions
- -Check >Resample Bicubic
- -Resolution > leave unchanged
